



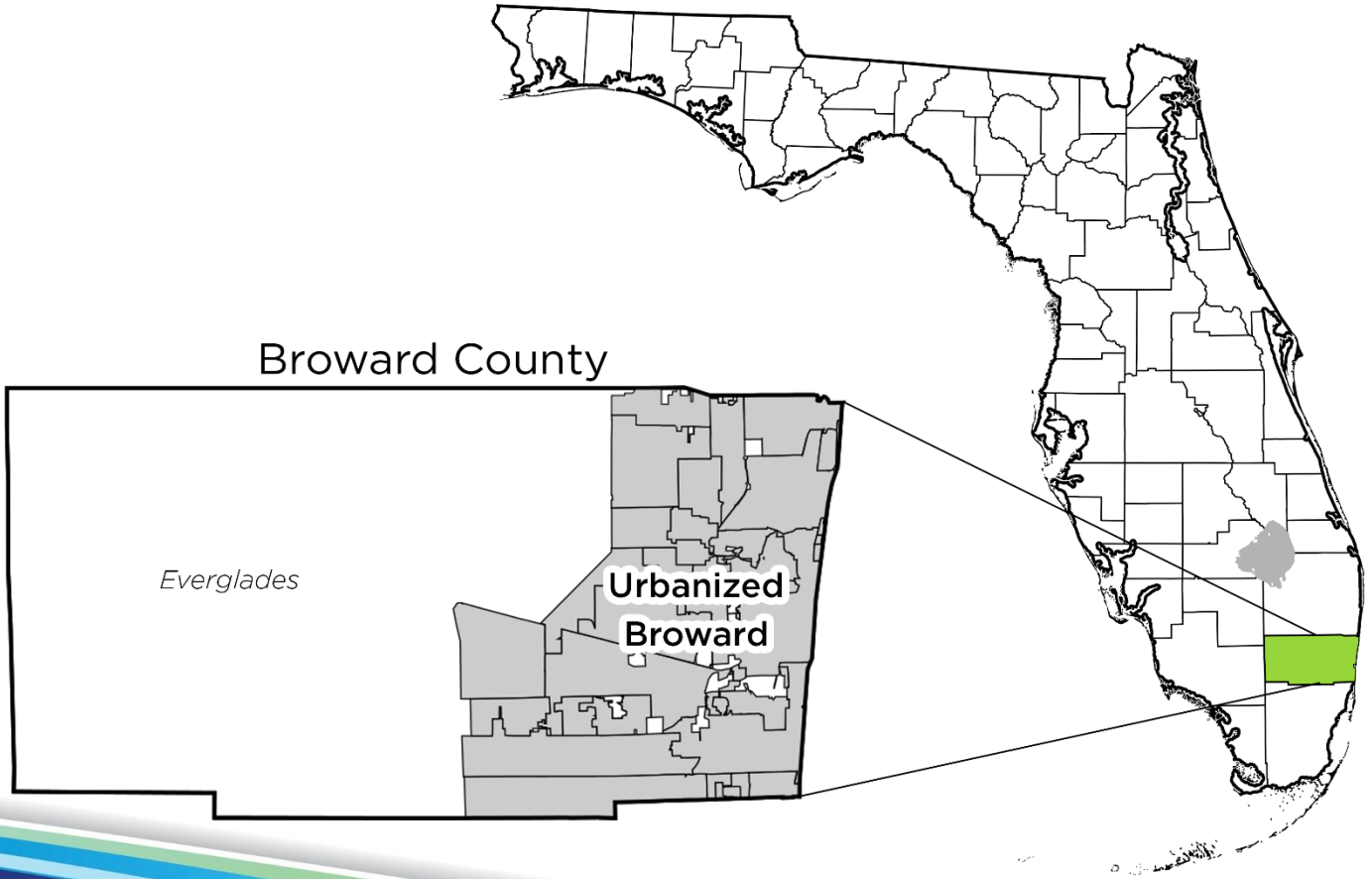

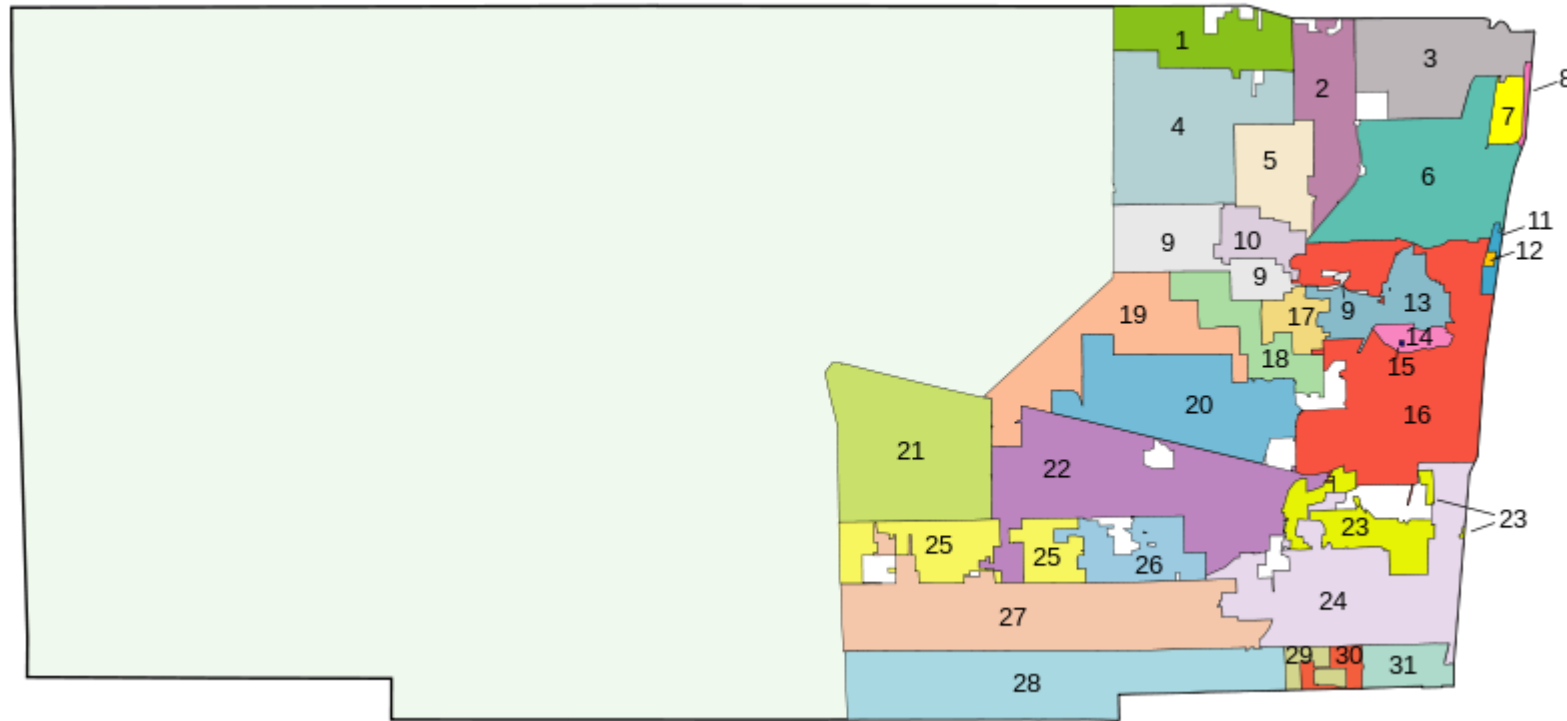

The Problem

- Candidate projects in the Broward MPO's plans and programs could not be implemented due to a lack of consistent project scope and vetting
- Member governments have a varying degree of resources available to develop a list of vetted projects
- Needed to establish a baseline with member governments

MPO MISSION STATEMENT

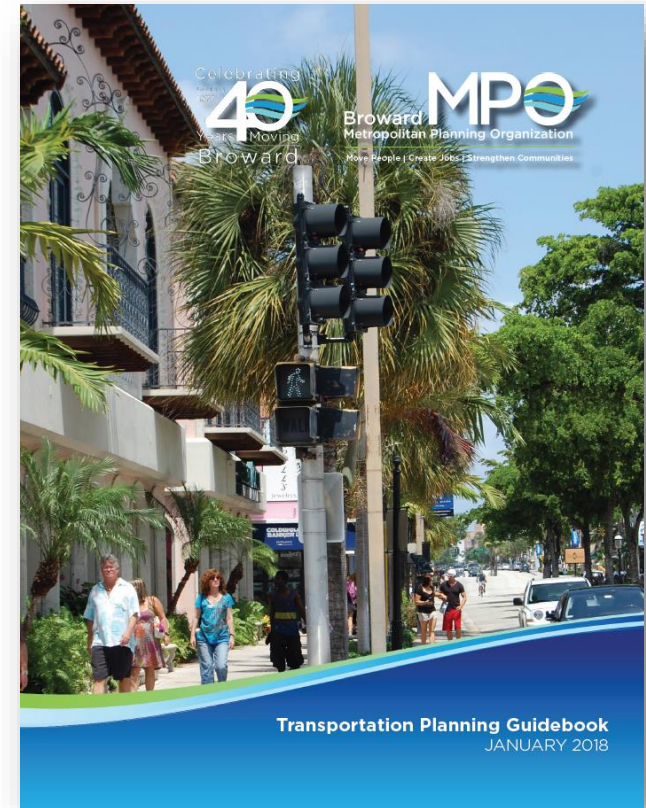
To collaboratively plan, prioritize and fund the delivery of diverse transportation options.

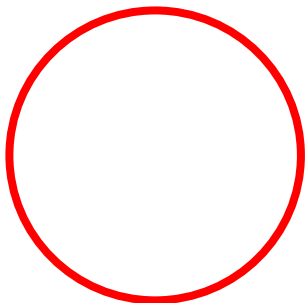
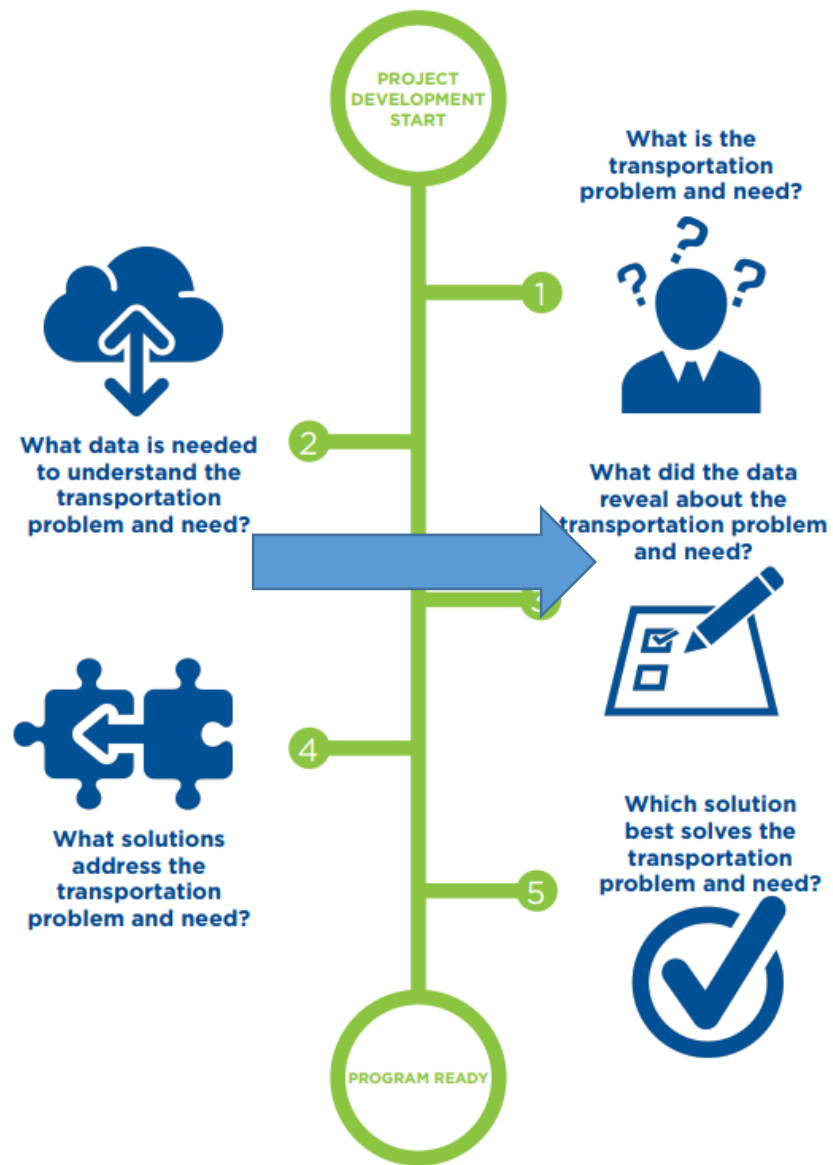

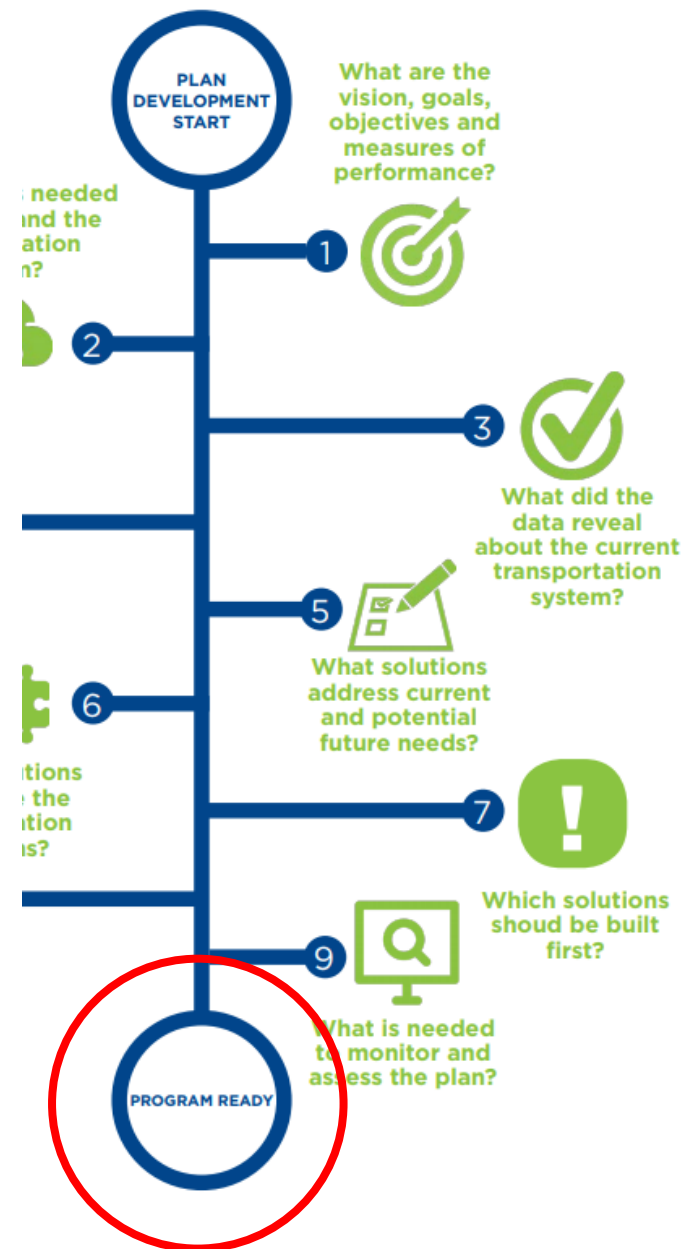
How to become program ready?

-  **Scope of Work** – Is there a purpose and need for the project?
-  **Cost Estimate** – Are project costs realistic?
-  **Partner Collaboration** – Contacted owner/operator for buy-in?
-  **Resolutions** – Is there public and political support?

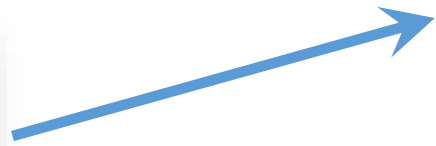
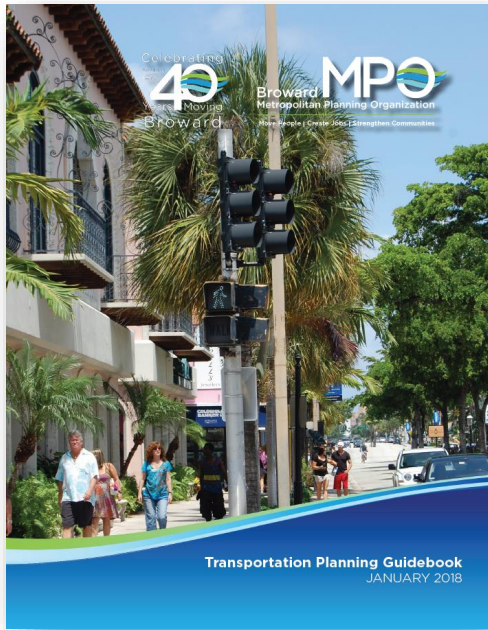


Support to Member Governments
