Master's degree in urban/regional planning, geography, public administration, architecture, civil engineering, environmental science, economics or related field; or any equivalent combination of related training and experience. A valid Florida Driver License is required and a Motor Vehicle Record that meets the requirements of Alachua County policy # 6-7; Motor Vehicle Records will be reviewed prior to employment. If in the past 24-month period, the record shows more than 3 moving traffic violations, and/or a conviction/pending charge for driving under the influence, the minimum qualifications are not met for the position. Successful completion of a criminal history background investigation is required prior to employment. Applicants within six months of meeting the minimum education/experience requirement may be considered for trainee status. This Planner position has the potential to perform a wide variety planning duties such as: Comprehensive Plan Policy Analysis, Zoning Review, Development Plan Review, and Land Development Code Research and Writing. This work culminates in comprehensive reports and presentations used by decision-making bodies such as the Board of County Commissioners, Planning Commission, and the Development Review Committee. A successful employee in this position would be knowledgeable about the technical and professional disciplines associated new development and redevelopment. This employee will need to complete site inspections, review detailed applications, coordinate reviews with other staff members, write reports, present findings at official public meetings, and assist applicants throughout each step of the required processes.
